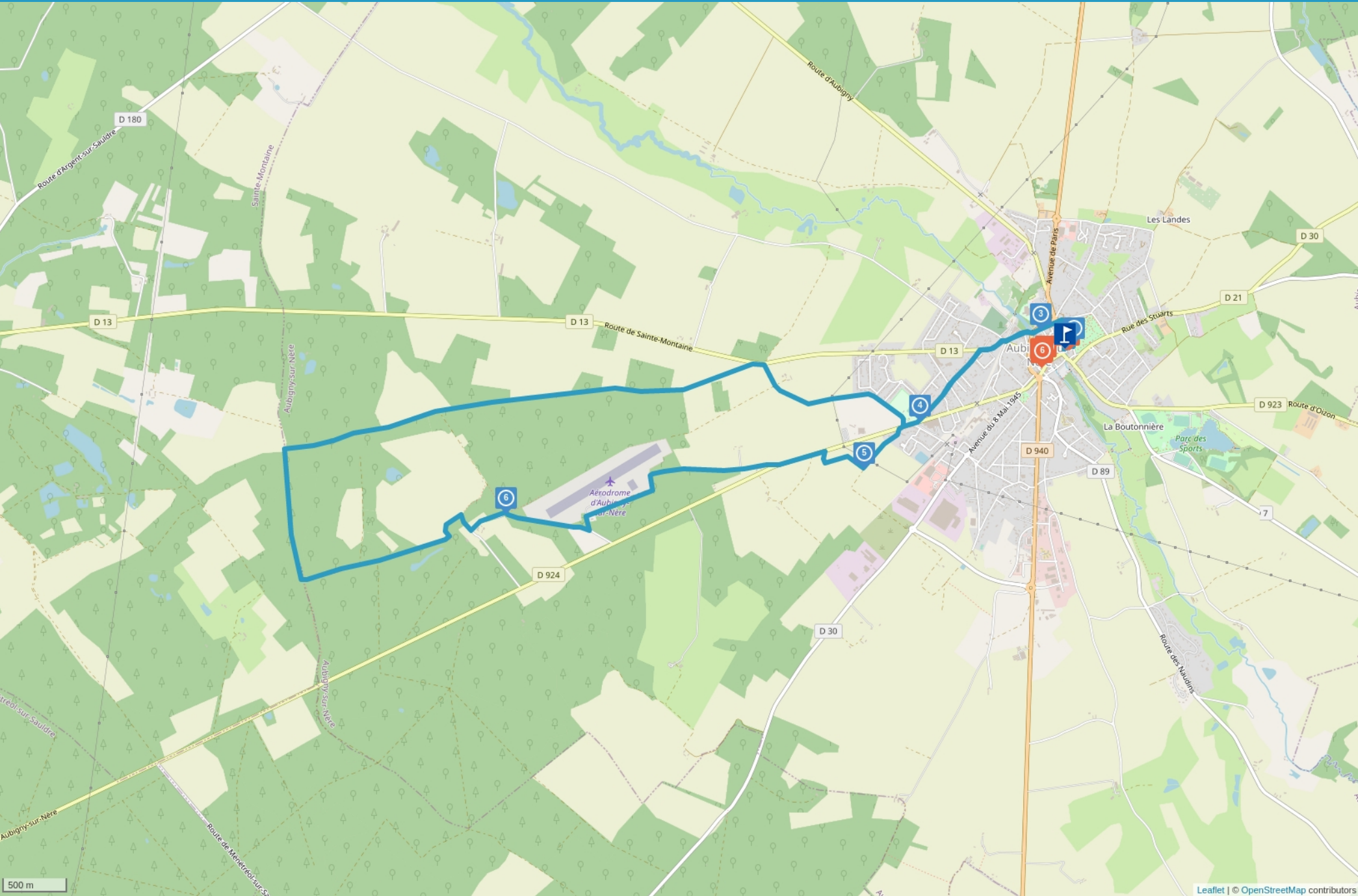




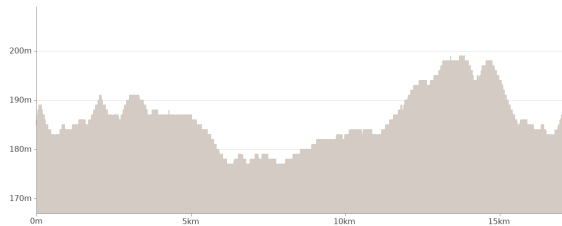

OT Saultre et Sologne



Départ : Place de la Résistance - 18700 AUBIGNY-SUR-NÈRE



A walk crossing between wooded and farm land. Aubigny-sur-Nère, Small City of character and "Ville Fleurie" (flowers distinction in a city), is a Scottish city in France. It maintains its close links with Scotland during the Franco-Scottish Festivals which take place each year around July 14. For a weekend, kilts bagpipes and pipe bands invade the City of the Stuarts to celebrate the Auld Alliance.

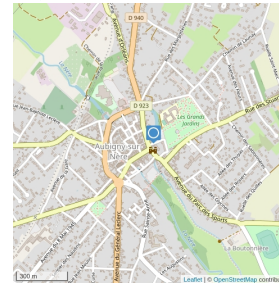

Rue Cambournac - 18700 AUBIGNY-SUR-NÈRE - Altitude : 186m

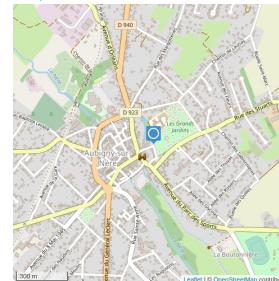


Start and finish : The castle

Place de la Résistance - 18700 AUBIGNY-SUR-NÈRE - Altitude : 190m

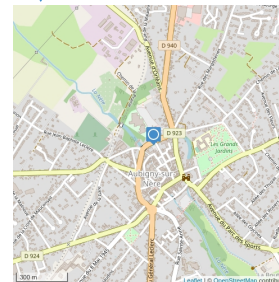


Step 1

At the entrance to "Les Grands Jardins" (the great gardens) walk alongside the "boules" pitch on your left and go straight on following the yellow and red signs of the GR du Pays (the signposted path on your right leads to "L'Etang du Puits").

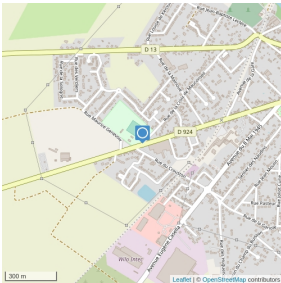
Step 2

Walk along the Nère river, cross the bridge (Le Pont Beaumont) and go towards Sainte Montaine. Continue to follow the signs, pass the "Centre de secours" then take the "Rue de la Croix de Mauconseil" to come out on to the D924 at the "Stade Saint Paul".

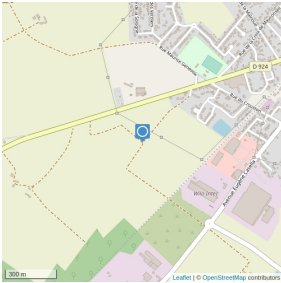


Step 3

Cross the D924, follow the signposted path (you will have to go along the road for about 500 metres to come back to the CR on your right) and this takes you to the aerodrome.

18700 AUBIGNY-SUR-NÈRE - Altitude : 199m

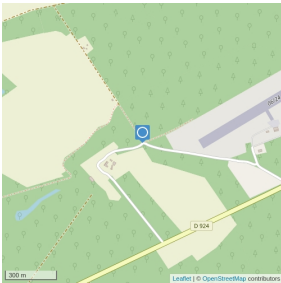


Step 4

Continue along the signposted path and after a bend on the right (before the D924) you will pass along the end of the runway and then go round "Le Domaine de la Théau".

18700 AUBIGNY-SUR-NÈRE - Altitude : 184m



Step 5

The signposted path comes out on to the "Chemin de Tempête" where it slopes down to the left to come back to Ménétréol-sur-Sauldre. Keep a straight face. Then turn right at the intersection. Then turn right at the first path. Follow "le Chemin de Tillou" until you reach the D13. Then you have to go off on the right along the "Chemin de la Procession" to come back to the GR de Pays at the Parc Saint Paul which takes you back to the castle path by "La Rue de la Croix Mauconseil".

The Stuarts' Castle

Béraud and Robert Stuart, formerly Lords of Aubigny, contemporaries of Leonardo da Vinci, built the Aubigny castle in the XVIth century. 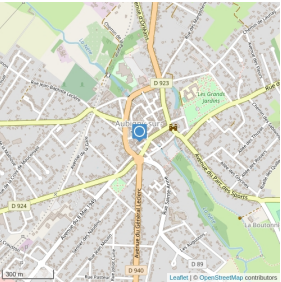

The Church "Saint-Martin"

This church is attested from the IXth century, it is dedicated to Saint-Martin (bishop of Tours in the IVth century). During the Hundred Years War, the church was burnt down by the English twice (in 1356 then in 1412). The side chapels and the choir were built by Robert Stuart, following the fire of 1512. A keystone bears his coat of arms and could be dated to the years 1517-1527.
