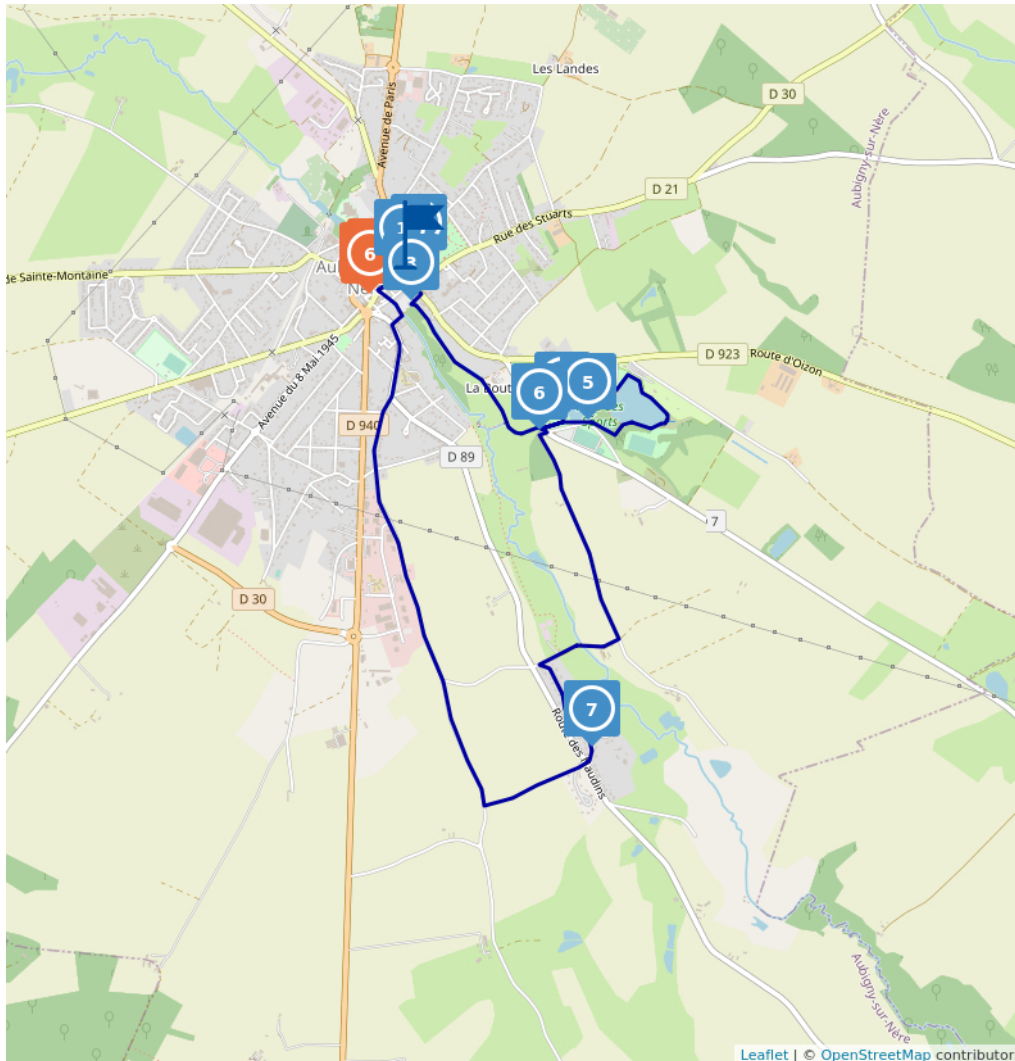


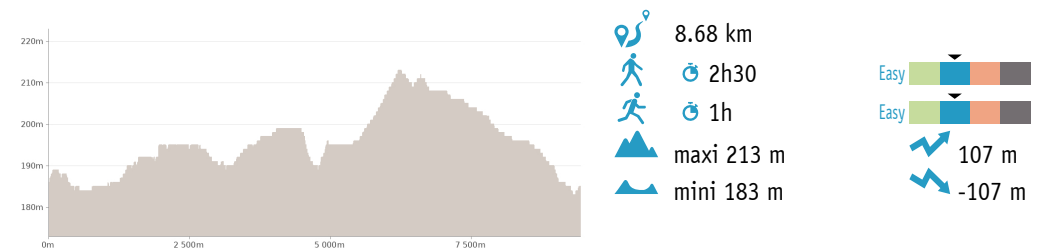
Aubigny-sur-Nère - The "moulin du bois" itinerary

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This walk enables you to discover the facilities at the Parc des Sports, the ponds and the Nère river. Aubigny-sur-Nère, Small City of Character and "Ville Fleurie" (flowers distinction in a city), is a Scottish city in France. It maintains its close links with Scotland during the Franco-Scottish Festivals which take place each year around July 14. For a weekend, kilts bagpipes and pipe bands invade the City of the Stuarts to celebrate the Auld Alliance.

The Stuarts' Castle

Béraud and Robert Stuart, formerly Lords of Aubigny, contemporaries of Leonardo da Vinci, built the Aubigny castle in the XVIth century.

Visit without delay the Interpretation Center of the Auld Alliance which is located in the enclosure of the castle to learn more about this incredible story that links Aubigny-sur-Nère to Scotland !

Château, Eglise & Abbaye, Patrimoine religieux

The Church "Saint-Martin"

This church is attested from the IXth century, it is dedicated to Saint-Martin (bishop of Tours in the IVth century). During the Hundred Years War, the church was burnt down by the English twice (in 1356 then in 1412). The side chapels and the choir were built by Robert Stuart, following the fire of 1512. A keystone bears his coat of arms and could be dated to the years 1517-1527.

Start and finish

Start and finish at the castle, place de la résistance. Go up towards "les Grands Jardins" (the great gardens).

2

Place de la Résistance 18700 AUBIGNY-SUR-NÈRE

Step 1

Don't go in the great gardens but turn right alongside the school towards La Place Paul Lasnier. Cross the square towards the La Chaumière hotel. Cross the avenue du Parc des Sports and turn right into the Ruelle des Prés.

Step 2

This takes you to a large car park. Turn left on to a path running alongside the Nère river which leads to the old swimming pool park.

4

Step 3

Cross the car park, walk towards the old outdoor pool to reach the little pond. Walk along the left side of the little pond and go up the steps to get the embankment of the large pond. Go round the large pond on your left towards the campsite, then leave the embankment near the tennis courts.

Step 4

Leave the parc and turn right to come back to the D7 alongside the rugby ground. Cross the road, turn left on to the CR des Marnières and follow it for about 1 km.

Step 5

Turn right on to a path which leads to the Moulin au Bois (a mill). Go down towards the Nère river, cross the footbridge and take the first street on the left to cross "Le Domaine d'Aubigny".

Step 6

After crossing the D89, go up towards the CR de Mahys, turn right towards Aubigny, pass in front of the "Maison de Retraite" and you will arrive at "La rue Sainte Anne". Pass the no through road on your right, go through the "Ruelle des Prés" and go into the castle courtyard after crossing the "Place Paul Lasnier".
