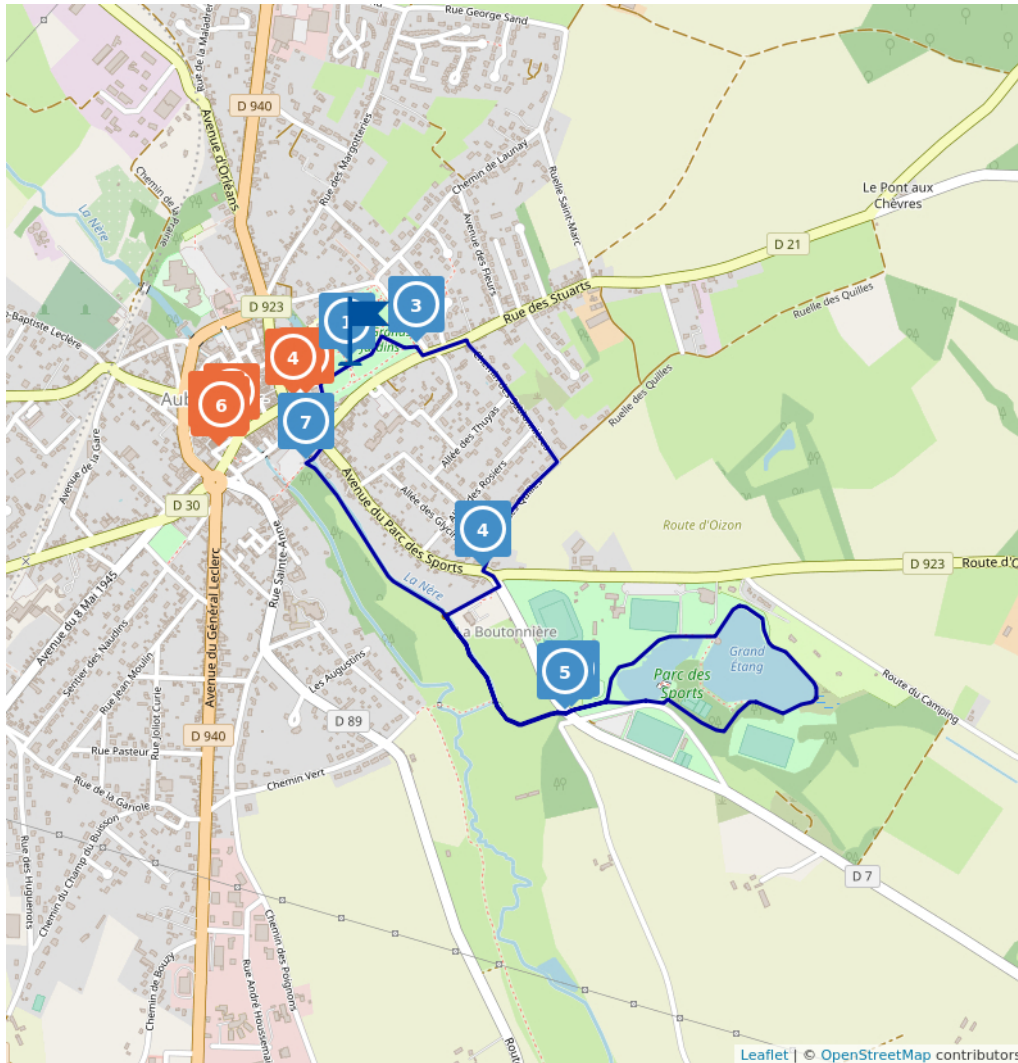


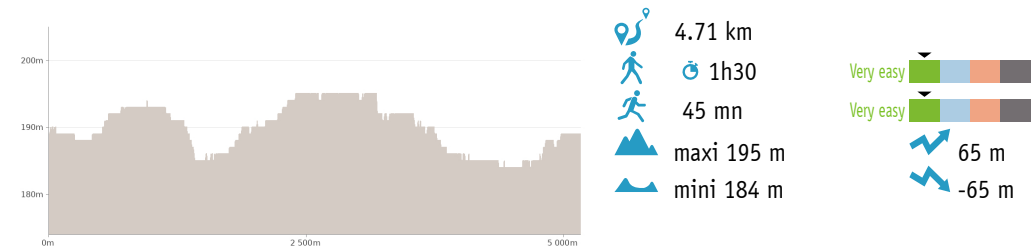
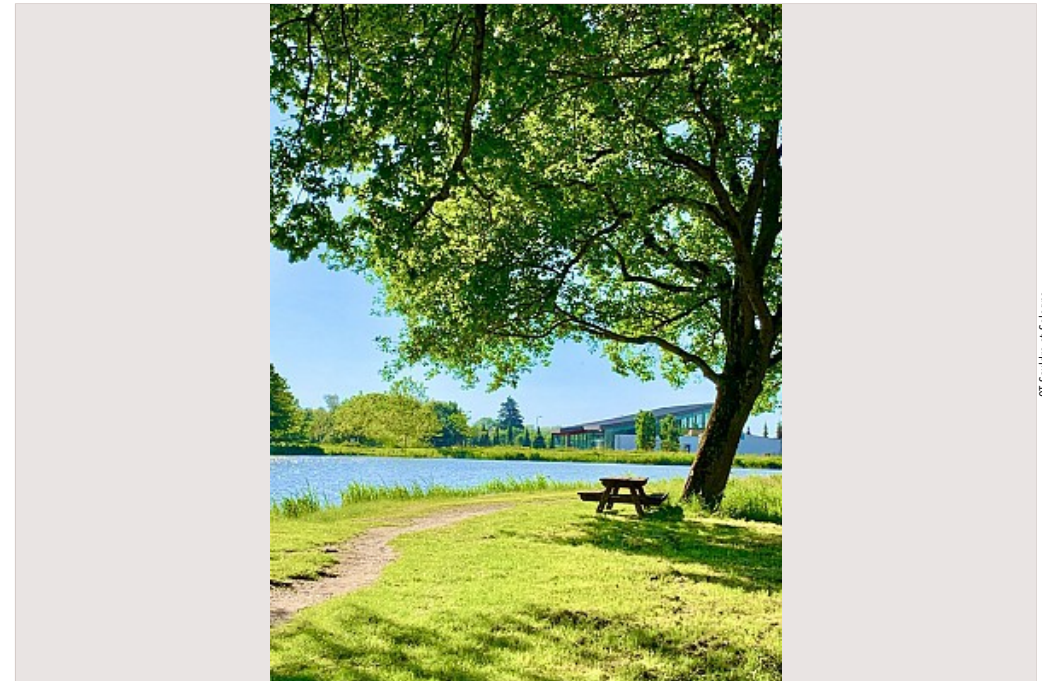
Aubigny-sur-Nère - The "parc des sports" itinerary

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If you'd rather go for either a shorter walk, round the ponds, leave your car at the entrance to the "Parc des Sports" or at the old swimming pool car park. Aubigny-sur-Nère, Small City of Character and "Ville Fleurie" (flowers distinction in a city), is a Scottish city in France. It maintains its close links with Scotland during the Franco-Scottish Festivals which take place each year around July 14. For a weekend, kilts bagpipes and pipe bands invade the City of the Stuarts to celebrate the Auld Alliance.

The Stuarts' Castle

Béraud and Robert Stuart, formerly Lords of Aubigny, contemporaries of Leonardo da Vinci, built the Aubigny castle in the XVIth century.

Visit without delay the Interpretation Center of the Auld Alliance which is located in the enclosure of the castle to learn more about this incredible story that links Aubigny-sur-Nère to Scotland !

Château, Eglise & Abbaye, Patrimoine religieux

The Church "Saint-Martin"

This church is attested from the IXth century, it is dedicated to Saint-Martin (bishop of Tours in the IVth century). During the Hundred Years War, the church was burnt down by the English twice (in 1356 then in 1412). The side chapels and the choir were built by Robert Stuart, following the fire of 1512. A keystone bears his coat of arms and could be dated to the years 1517-1527.

Start and finish : The castle

Start and finish at the castle, place de la résistance.

Step 1

Follow the central avenue in the "Grands Jardins" (the great gardens) towards the statue "Le Passé et l'Avenir" (The past and the future statue).

Step 2

Turn right and then take the second on the right into the "Chemin des Sablonnières". Turn right at the end of this road into "la Ruelle des Quilles" which brings you out on to La Route d'Oizon opposite to the entrance to the "Parc des Sports".

Step 3

Cross this road and go up towards the old swimming pool car park.

Step 4

Continue alongside the children's playgrounds (which is on your right) towards the little pond. Follow the river bank on your right until you come to the steps that take you up to the old bar. Walk around this pond and then go down the steps and walk alongside the little pond to come back to the river path.

Step 5

Follow the path until you come to a large car park. Just before you get to the car park, turn right over a little footbridge into "la Ruelle des Prés", turn left at the end and then turn right past the La Chaumière hotel. Cross the "Place Paul Lasnier" (the square) and go into the gardens to get back to the castle.
